

How Do I Know If My Pet Can Benefit From Integrative Medicine?

Integrative medicine is simply using one or more forms of alternative treatments in addition to the conventional treatments your veterinarian recommends for your pet.

ASK YOURSELF THESE QUESTIONS:

- Does my pet have arthritis or other painful condition and is still in pain even though I give medications once or twice a day?
- Is my older pet less interactive, sleeping more, limping, moving slower, or not eating as well? Do I say "he's just getting old?"
- Does my pet have a chronic disorder that never really goes away, even though he's been on many different medications?
- Does my pet have cancer? Is there anything else I can do in addition to OR instead of chemotherapy/radiation? Can anything be done to help my pet go through chemotherapy?
- Is my pet on medications with side effects? How can I make his quality of life better on these medications?
- Does my pet just seem a bit "off" and no one knows why? Has your primary veterinarian done bloodwork and other diagnostic tests and they all are normal?
